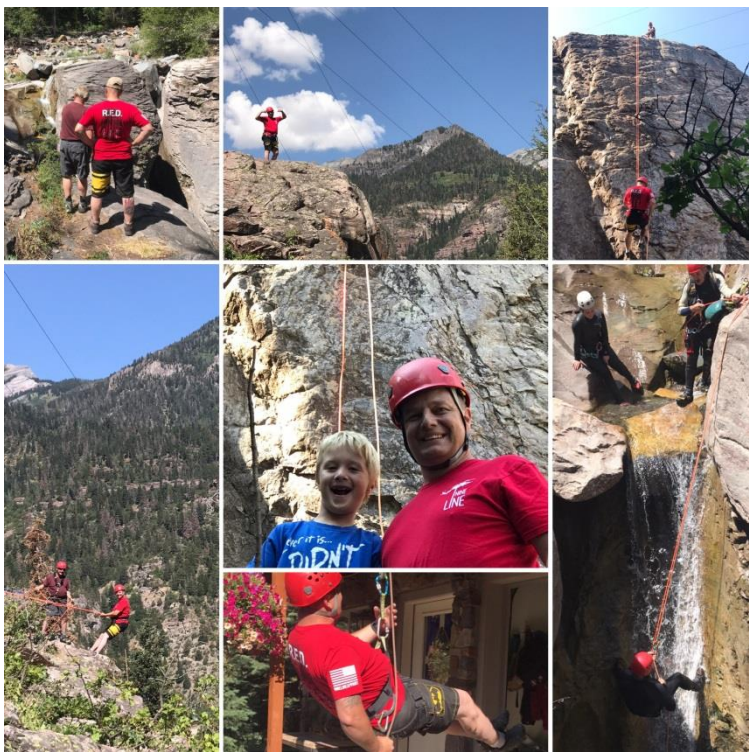


Veterans and Family Canyon Adventure Days



Alpine canyoning is the adventure of exploring steep narrow mountain canyons by descending them usually in the water flow. The canyoneer uses special clothing (wet and dry suits), ropes, and techniques to hike, down-climb, and rappel, whatever obstacles are encountered.

The Veterans and Family Canyon Adventure Days will be an Introductory Workshop designed to introduce adventurers to the sport of canyoning.

Each adventure day will be conducted by a local guide service. These adventures are free to veterans registered with the Welcome Home
